

**Peace and Dignity Camp June 8-10, 2012  
and Spring Intensive, June 11**



We are pleased to announce the Peace and Dignity Camp 2012. We will be camping as friends and family this year in Chaplin CT from Friday evening until Sunday afternoon.

As in the past, Maestro Tlakael, Mexica-Tolteca Elder and Man of Knowledge, will act as the Spiritual Advisor for the camp. The Peace and Dignity Camp is a family event and children are both welcomed and encouraged to attend. All camp work responsibilities will be shared by those in attendance. The Camp is a Spiritual gathering, so of course drugs, alcohol and weapons are strictly prohibited, and no pets will be permitted on the grounds. All meals will be provided for everyone (prepared by you volunteers) Friday night, on Saturday, and brunch on Sunday. Each camper is responsible for their own tents, camping gear, and trash. As the camp happens by all of our efforts & participation, volunteers are welcome to ask for how to assist. whatever is of interest to you! Consider what you can offer and let us know, come early to help, or assist in other ways for everyone's benefit!

We traditionally offer a temezkal (sweatlodge) at Peace Camp for those interested. It is a traditional way of coming together to acknowledge and give thanks for our connection with Creator, each other and the Earth, It is an opportunity to look within and without to appreciate the depth and beauty that life offers. As our Elders' health permits, Tlakael will lead one of these ceremonies for all to participate in as space allows.

Here are some ideas on topics that Tlakael may discuss, and we will also share in circle. Some will be experiential sessions, and Tlakael may lead a guided meditation as well; How to view auras and energies, Transferring energy to thought/thought to energy, How we interact with our environment and the Earth, How do we live our spirituality in day to day life, and How to incorporate ceremony, into daily life, Stages of life; how kids grow and develop, young adults learn, and adults age with purpose, How our sense of purpose can guide our lives. We will also have some group discussion time where we can all share our ideas with each other. These can be touched on during Peace Camp, and gone into in more detail during the one day Intensive on Monday. Please feel free to add ideas for topics by sending ahead.



We are requesting a minimum donation of \$30 to \$45 from each individual, and \$65 to \$105 for families **for the Peace Camp**, to help defray the costs of food and to assist the Elders with their travel expenses and to help support our work. **For the one day Intensive with Tlakael (bring your questions), we request a donation of 45-75 if possible.
